*TASTING NOTES:*

This wine has an intense, dark inky color offering aromas of wild blackberry and baked current along with subtle notes of violets followed by savory notes of dried sage/rosemary flower, allspice and toasted oak. The palate texture is fine grained and persistent throughout, while offering silkiness of tannins with flavors of pomegranate/cherry compote, tamarind-candied cassis and black olive. This wine will be best enjoyed from 2018 to 2028.
